

Dear Supplier,

We wish to inform you of an important enhancement to our sourcing process.

As part of Leonardo Group commitment to sustainability and responsible business practices, Telespazio S.p.A. will incorporate Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) criteria into all business tenders with an estimated value of €1 million or more, starting in September 2025.

This initiative is in line with other recently started programs, including the adoption of decarbonization targets validated by the Science Based Target initiative (SBTi)¹ and the roll-out of the EcoVadis² ESG assessment in accordance to the AD&S Sector initiative promoted by IAEG³ (International Aerospace Environmental Group) association.

Embedding ESG criteria, alongside the economic and technical criteria already in use, reflects Leonardo Group's dedication to align with global Sustainability goals, reduce our climate footprint and ensure that our supply chain partners share our values and commitment regarding environmental responsibility, social impact, and governance standards.

The specific ESG criteria are:

- **ESG performance:** availability of a valid **EcoVadis** sustainability assessment, completed not later than 18 months ago, and the corresponding rating (from 0 to 100).
- **Decarbonization - SBTi adherence:** evidence of a formal commitment to, or validated targets by, the Science-Based Targets initiative (SBTi).
- Additional ESG criteria may be added, depending on the scope of supply.

We look forward to continuing our collaboration and appreciate your efforts to contribute to a more sustainable and responsible future.
